How to apply?	All students must be nominated by their home University. Selected students have to send in the following documents, before the application deadline, to exchange_students@ue-varna.bg for checking: Learning Agreement Housing Application Form (if needed) After approval, the original documents + 4 hardcopy photos must be sent by post mail to the university address
Tuition fees	All exchange incoming students coming from partner universities are exempt from any tuition fees

Visa	All Non-European students must have a valid VISA. In order to apply for it, they must receive an admission letter.
Language skills	All students enrolled in an exchange program must have a minimum level of B1-B2 in the language of instruction. All students enrolled in an exchange program leading to a diploma of the University of Economics - Varna must have a minimum level of B2 in the language of instruction.
